Some of these characters will fall in love, some will have desperate adventures and some will save the world – all while traveling everywhere from the Jungle of Nool to McElligott's Pool to Palm Beach!

A young girl, Jojo, a "thinker of strange and wonderful thinks!" brings the colorful and classic tales together. There's the Cat in the Hat, Horton the Elephant, Gertrude McFuzz, the Whos of Whoville, including the Mayor and his Wife, the General Genghis Kahn Schmitz, Mayzie LaBird, Sour Kangaroo and the Citizens of the Jungle of Nool.

Dr. Seuss believes in the pure power of imagination, helping a friend, keeping a promise and not giving up. He also believes in the value and dignity of others, working to preserve the fragile sweetness of the natural world, and that peace is the ultimate ideal, among nations and in every heart. As each of the stories unfolds, you will see how relevant and profound Dr. Seuss's subtle themes are.

Theodore "Seuss" Geisel

Theodore Geisel (Dr. Seuss) was born in Springfield, MA, in 1904. He changed the world of children's literature with his first book *And to Think That I Saw it on Mulberry Street*, which made its way to bookstores only after being rejected by 28 different publishers. In 1957, Seuss fused 225 words with rhyme and humor to create *The Cat in the Hat* and went on to inspire four generations to read. He defied the establishment and revolutionized the process that children use to learn and read. "Children want the same things we want. To laugh, to be challenged, and to be entertained and delighted," he said. The author and illustrator of 44 books, he received the Pulitzer Prize, two Emmys, three Academy Awards and remains the world's best-selling author of children's books.
